***** ENTRY INFORMATION MUST INCLUDE *****

1. Completed entry form and Entry Fees.
2. Registration certificate or copy of certificate. For animals not yet registered, furnish the name, tattoo, date of birth, sex, and registration numbers of sire and dam. Calf pedigrees will not be in catalog unless registration numbers are furnished.
3. EPDs: Angus website will be used to acquire the most current EPDs available.
4. Footnotes: (What you send me will be your only footnote in the catalog. Include any or all of the following.)
 - A. Calving data such as sex, date of birth, sire, birth weight.
 - B. Breeding data: Service sire, date of service, pregnancy exam.
 - C. Performance data and/or production records.
 - D. Health and vaccinations.
 - E. Other pertinent information.

Remember, genomic testing is now required for all bull entries. If you get them done now, results should be available prior to catalog press time.

******* QUALIFICATIONS *******

I. EPDs

- A. Each bull must have individual EPDs (or parents with interim EPDs so that estimated individual EPDs can be calculated) for Birth Weight, Weaning Weight, Milk, and Yearling Weight. It is not required that bull entries in CKA sales be genomic tested to sell. Get it done now!
- B. Each bull must have at least ONE EPD that ranks in the top 35% of the breed. The numerical requirement for the top 35% of each of the EPDs is listed with the respective EPD (figures from Spring 2020 report).
To qualify, a bull's EPD must be equal to or greater than the listed EPD except for birth weight and carcass fat, which must be equal to or less than the listed EPD

II. FERTILITY:

Each bull must pass a breeding soundness examination administered by a qualified technician within 60 days of the sale. Results of the exam must be recorded on a form provided by and signed by the issuing technician. Forms will be presented to the sale manager along with the customary health paper upon delivery of the bull to the sale facilities.

III. PERFORMANCE DATA

- A. Actual in herd weights will not be required this year, however, CKA strongly recommends that you record birth, weaning, and yearling weights and process these weights through the AHIR program of the American Angus Association.
- B. Sale Weights: All bulls will be weighed upon delivery to the sale facilities and must meet or exceed the following minimums for weight per day of age.

No additional weight requirements over 30 months.

IV. GENOMIC TEST: Required for all bulls in a CKA sale.

V. AGE: Bulls born from 1-1-2017 to 4-30-2019.

VI. FEES

- A. Entry Fees: Premier Bulls must pay an additional fee of \$25.00 each over and above the regular sale entry fees.
- B. Premiums: All additional entry fees collected will be paid as premiums to the top selling bulls. Distribution of premiums will be determined by the sale committee prior to the sale. To qualify for premiums, bulls must be fully paid for and papers must be transferred to the new owner.
- C. Sale Expenses will be calculated the same as the balance of the sale cattle.

VII. MISCELLANEOUS

- A. Bulls that do not meet the premier qualifications will be accepted only if less than 30 premier bulls are consigned
- B. Sale order will be determined by the sale manager in consultation with the Sale committee.
