***** **ENTRY INFORMATION SHOULD INCLUDE** *****

1. Completed entry form and Entry Fee of \$50.00 per lot plus \$25.00 per head. Embryos: \$50.00 per lot plus \$25.00 per additional pedigree.
2. Registration number. For animals not yet registered, furnish the name, tattoo, date of birth, sex, and registration numbers of sire and dam, but please go ahead and register them now!
3. EPDs: Angus website will be used to acquire the most current EPDs and other data.
4. **Footnotes: (Include any or all of the following. Your footnotes in the catalog will be what you provide to me.)**
 - A. Calving data such as sex, date of birth, sire, birth weight.
 - B. Breeding data: Service sire, date of service, pasture exposure period, pregnancy exam.
 - C. Performance data and/or production records.
 - D. Herd health status.
 - E. Other info, i.e., show records or sales of progeny or siblings, etc
